

2015 Lifetime Achievement Recipient — Muhammad Asim Khan, MD, FRCP, MACP, MACR

Dr. Khan received his medical degree in 1965, served in the Pakistan Army Medical Corp and in 1967 began his postgraduate studies in England, and 2 years later continued that in the United States. After completing his Fellowship in Rheumatology in 1973 he joined the faculty at Case Western Reserve University where he was tenured Professor of Medicine till 2012, when he was awarded the title of Professor Emeritus of Medicine. His research interests focus primarily on spondyloarthritis and has authored 2 books, edited 16 yearly reviews, a book and a monograph, and has authored/co-authored 226 scientific articles and 45 book chapters. He is Section Editor for *Current Rheumatology Reports* and a founding member of ASAS, SPARTAN and GRAPPA; these are professional research organizations interested in spondyloarthritis. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (*FRCP*), *Master* of the American College of Physicians (*MACP*) and the American College of Rheumatology (*MACR*), and a recipient of the *Distinguished Rheumatologist Award* from the ACR. Other awards include Distinguished Alumnus Award of Academic Excellence, SPARTAN Lifetime Achievement Award, and two awards from the Spondylitis Association of America. Last year he was inducted into Medical Hall of Honor at MetroHealth Medical Center.
